B. The Serb National Federation is licensed to do business in the state of Ohio. As a tax-exempt entity, Fraternal Benefit Societies are not included in the Ohio Guaranty Association. This means that Fraternal Benefit Societies cannot be assessed for the insolvency of other life insurers or other Fraternal Benefit Societies. By law, a Fraternal Benefit Society is responsible for its own solvency. If there is an impairment of reserves, a certificate holder may be assessed a proportional share of the impairment. This process is described in the certificates issued by the Society.
